

QUEEN'S CUP FACT SHEET

2012

We are providing this fact sheet to clarify the format used to determine this year's Queen!

Format: 18 hole singles match play. Any matches ending in a tie will continue in sudden death starting on hole #1. Matches will be handicapped stroking off the low ball. I.e. If a 20 and a 25 handicap play, 5 strokes will be given to the 25 handicap on the applicable holes. (25-20). Max. handicap will be 40.

Seeding: We will have 2 Flights based on Handicaps. Players will be seeded by handicap index, with the lowest index receiving the #1 seed. Depending on the amount of players, we will have byes in the first round. The USGA general numerical draw will determine the pairings.

Handicap: Players will play to their most recent handicaps throughout the tournament.

Schedule: NOTE: Matches should be completed within a 10 day time frame and is the responsibility of the competitors to schedule the matches in the Pro shop. We will take tee times for matches early. The Matches must be played with KLA members only. Remember-Matches cannot take place on Thursday morning Ladies day.

Basic Rules: In match play, the ball farther from the hole is played first. The winner of a hole tees off first on the next hole. If a player plays out of turn anywhere on the course, her opponent may require her to replay the shot or that shot can stand.

***Remember if you miss a putt, make sure you mark it and not tap it in. Your opponent can conceded your putt.**
